## ABOUT GGAA

Join us at the GGAA2025 conference, a gathering of leading scientists in the field of emissions from animal agriculture. The conference will be taking place in Nairobi, Kenya from October 5 to 9, 2025, hosted by the **International Livestock Research Institute (ILRI)** and the **Norwegian Institute of Bioeconomy Research (NIBIO)**.

## THE GGAA JOURNEY

The Conference convenes triennially, traversing continents with each recurrence. Its inaugural assembly, GGAA2003, was held in Japan, accommodating 200 delegates representing 20 nations. Sequential iterations unfolded as follows: GGAA2005 in Switzerland; GGAA2007 in New Zealand; GGAA2010 in Canada, culminating in the most substantial turnout at GGAA2013 in Ireland, boasting 460 delegates from 41 countries. GGAA2016 in Australia attracted more than 300 delegates from 36 nations. Subsequent conferences were held in Foz do Iguassu, Brazil, in 2019 and in Orlando, Florida, USA, in 2022.



## GGAA2025, NAIROBI, KENYA

This sanctuary is teeming with diverse wildlife, including the highest concentration of black rhinos across Africa, offering residents and visitors a unique juxtaposition of urban living and wildlife encounters.
